The award is the result of a rigorous assessment. Companies must first qualify in the top 20% of the country based on a nationally representative sample of employers. The largest part of the assessment is an employee survey which evaluates employers on six components of an effective workplace: opportunities for learning; a culture of trust; work/life fit; supervisor support for work success; autonomy; and satisfaction with earnings, benefits and opportunities for advancement – all factors associated with employee health, well-being and engagement.
