Henry+Horne employees participate in 9/11 stair climb to honor first responders lost



Tempe – September 13, 2021- To honor the memory of those who lost their lives on September 11, on Saturday a group of Henry+Horne employees, friends and family participated in the 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb. The group weaved through the Salt River Field stadium, climbing over 2,000 stairs, the equivalent of the two tower's 110 stories. Each climber carried the name and picture of one of the fallen throughout the climb, symbolically completing their journey to the top of the World Trade Center Towers.

"I think anyone in attendance would tell you what a humbling experience it was to be climbing those steps next to firefighters in their full gear. It was an absolute honor to be able to pay tribute to the fallen first responders who lost their lives on 9/11," said Henry+Horne Manager Courtnee Greshner.

The climb, hosted by the Salt River Indian Community Fire Department, is in its fifth year and is part of the National Fallen Firefighters 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb. This year's climb raised \$85,000 for programs provided by the NFFF to support the families of local fallen firefighters and the FDNY Counseling Services Unit.
